- 3 Artificial Reefs had recently been positioned in Port Phillip Bay and there are plans for a further 2 more on the western side of the bay. Renso has the GPS coordinates for these reefs if anybody is interested.
- VR Fish has been reviewing the native fish policies and has the results on their website.
- Rec Fish will not be funded so may fold.
- Tooridan funding for the dredging has been approved. This will provide access for boat launching during all tides.
- Williamson beach will not be closed for the desalination plant. At this stage, the only portion of the area to be closed is the area for the desalination plant itself.
