Competition Rules

1. Fishing is permitted from Boat, Pier, Shore or River Bank.
2. Fishing is restricted to Port Phillip Bay and Inlets.
3. The following species size and bag limits will apply for weighing in:

Snapper.

Must comply with the current Victorian Regulations except the minimum weigh in length will be 30cm.

Flathead

Maximum 2 fish per day per angler with minimum length of 30cm.

Whiting

Maximum 2 fish per day per angler with minimum length of 30cm.

Bream

Maximum 2 fish per day per angler with minimum length of 27cm.

Mullet

Maximum 2 fish per day per angler with minimum length of 25cm.

Garfish

Maximum 2 fish per day per angler with minimum length of 27cm.

4. All fish must be presented GUTTED and GILLED BUT NOT SCALED.
5. Mutilated fish will not be accepted for weighing in any container holding water (ice acceptable)
6. Fish will not be accepted for weighing in any container holding water (ice acceptable)
7. All fishing must comply with the current regulations of the State of Victoria.
8. All fish will be scrutinised with the Scrutineer's decision being final.
9. The Judge's decision is final and binding and there will be no correspondence entered into.
10. Each competitor must hook and land their own fish with the only assistance being in the gaffing, gilling or netting of fish.
11. Any angler found in breach of the competition rules shall be subject to immediate disqualification.

Note: All anglers must hold a current Victorian Angling Licence in line with state requirements and statute's.
